Responsible to:

Mission:

The role of this Executive Member is to recognise and represent the views of female students at Swansea University Students' Union executive level.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

The Women's Officer role will work closely with the Full Time Officers and full time Union staff to help highlight, research and campaign on issues affecting women in the University, Students' Union and both locally and nationally.

It is expected the Women's Officer will keep up to date with work done nationally by NUS and other equality campaigns and pressure groups, as well as local and national government policy.

It is expected the Women's Officer will promote the message of the Union and encourage students who feel strongly about equality and equal rights to get involved in the Union.

As a member of the executive team it is expected that the Women's Officer will attend executive officer meetings as well as the Student Forums, at which the officer can feedback to the membership.

The Women's Officer role will develop useful connections between individuals and student groups that may help to increase involvement in campaigning and lobbying for more equality in the Union, University and both locally and nationally.

Furthermore, it is expected the Women's Officer will work on campaigns such as 'Reclaim the Night' and 'Confronting Lad Culture'.

The Women's Officer will be a key member of the Liberation Forums.
